Do I need a gas fitter to connect my new natural gas range?

When working with gas, you want to have a Certified Professional perform the work to ensure there are no leaks and that everything is safe for you and your family.

How long will this job take?

Connecting or disconnecting your natural gas range can be done in one day.

Are there specific venting requirements?

When burning gas, CO is emitted. It is necessary to have a proper hood fan installed above your new range. As per code, the clearances required are 24" from cooktop to bottom of hood fan (for non combustibles) and 30" from cooktop to bottom of combustible (like wood cabinets).

Does Alpha remove my old range?

Alpha Plumbing does not handle disposing of old ranges, as a practice.
